

Buriton's 'Village-to-Village' link with Dominase in rural Ghana

Buriton has developed strong links with the rural community of Dominase in the far north of the Central Region of Ghana over a number of years. The 'village-to-village' link involves residents across the entire communities in both countries. Groups of villagers work closely with each other to identify priorities and to coordinate assistance.

Living conditions in Dominase are fairly primitive and unhealthy. There is no running water and only a few wells and boreholes. The local river, often used for washing, is very dirty and can cause chronic disease and death. Mains electricity reached the community in 2009 but not everyone can afford it. Projects supported by the Buriton charity include water supplies, health facilities, education initiatives and sanitation improvements. Both Buriton Primary School and Ditcham Park School are linked with schools in the Dominase area. For more information please visit the website: www.buriton.info/dominase
