

Parish Councillors

The Council consists of 9 members. They are all unpaid, volunteer councillors whose task it is to work together to serve the interests of the Parish, bring local issues to the attention of Council, and help it make decisions on behalf of the local community.

Ordinary elections for Council membership take place every 4 years. The Council may choose someone to fill a vacancy if an insufficient number of candidates is proposed for election. If a vacancy occurs between elections, the Council must ascertain whether electors want an election to fill it (a by-election); if not, the Council can co-opt a suitable candidate instead.

At the Annual Meeting of the Council each May, members elect one of their number to act as Chairman for the forthcoming year. In addition, Council may elect a Vice-Chairman, agree which members will serve on Council's committees, act as bank account signatories etc.

All councillors are required to complete a Register of Interest form upon election/co-option. These forms are held by East Hampshire District Council.
