Minutes of a meeting of Buriton Parish Council Planning Committee held in Buriton Village Hall at 5.30pm on Monday 12<sup>th</sup> August 2019.

Present: Cllr Johnston (Chair), Cllr Ashcroft, Cllr Jones.

Apologies: none

- 1. Cllr Johnston opened the meeting.
- 2. Declarations of interest: Cllr Jones declared that as a Member of the South Downs National Park Authority, the Local Planning Authority for the area, he wished to make it clear that any views which he expressed at this meeting would be based on the information before him at this meeting and might change in the light of further information and/or debate at National Park meetings; this is to make it clear that he is keeping an open mind on the issues and cannot therefore be found to have predetermined any matter if it should come before the National Park for decision.
- **3. Minutes of last meeting** on 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2019 were approved as an accurate account and signed by the chairman.
- 4. Update on any key current planning matters

**SDNP/18/01060/FUL**: Ditcham Lane, Buriton, GU31 5RQ (Road improvements to existing track, including resurfacing, passing places, landscaping and wildlife enhancements): still in progress.

**SDNP/18/03797/DCND**: Butser Hill Lime Works Ltd, Butser Hill, Buriton, GU31 5SP. The application involves the potential demolition of lime kilns which, as previously noted, the Parish Council was seeking to save for potential future enjoyment when the site is restored. The planning decision included a mutual agreement not to demolish the kilns and Parish Council representatives had followed this up by meeting with the Hampshire Buildings Preservation Trust (and Buriton Village Association) and subsequently with SDNPA officers. The HBPT has subsequently submitted a letter of support to SDNPA as well as one from Keith Falconer, Past Chairman of the Association for Industrial Archaeology. It was noted that, since the last meeting of this Committee, the SDNPA had made the necessary application to Historic England to try to conserve these kilns and the outcome is awaited.

**SDNP/18/03611/FUL**: Stanbridge Farm, GU31 5RB: Change of use from Agricultural to mixed use with Seasonal Glamping, May to September. Decision pending

**SDNP/19/01440/DCOND** and **SDNP/19/01600/DCOND**. Discharge of various conditions at Monks Walk. Decision Pending. The Parish Council had written to Marta Karpezo (Southern Water) and representatives had subsequently met with her, near the site, to gain a fuller understanding of issues. This had resulted in the Parish Council sending a letter to Roger Burton, Drainage Officer, at EHDC. It was noted that, since the last meeting, a reply had been received from Mr Burton including the following points:

• I am unable to comment on the extent of Southern Water's responsibility, as their sewer records are incomplete.

- I have seen a copy of the drainage report and various defects are evident. Mr Camping has provided SDNPA with a signed undertaking that the necessary drainage repairs will be carried out within the next six months.
- With regard to the pumping station, no changes are proposed and therefore the peak discharge rate will not increase.
- Future responsibility for the foul drainage system will become the joint responsibility of the new residents.
- Surface water is being discharged to new soakaways and is not connected to the foul system. Again this will be the joint responsibility of the new residents.
- My responsibility is to advise EHDC/SDNPA and ensure all new developments have satisfactory drainage systems to cater for the 1:100 year + 40% climate change event and do not increase flood risk elsewhere. Foul drainage must discharge to the public foul sewer or a satisfactory private drainage arrangement.
