**Buriton Parish Council: Monitoring Statement as at August 2026
(to meet the CIL Reporting Requirements for 2025-26)**

A CIL payment of £3,154.59 was received in October 2025 for development which had taken place in the parish in preceding years.

There were several incidents of anti-social behaviour and vandalism on and around the village hall during the summer of 2025, this included external lights being damaged and a flag being raised on the roof which could have caused damage to the newly installed solar panels. As a result of this damage Councillors agreed at the Parish Council meeting on 29th September 2025, for the Village Hall Manager to obtain quotes for CCTV to be installed to cover the hall and surrounding area. They also agreed to use the monies awarded from the CIL payments for this.

Councillors agreed to a quote of £2,636 + VAT at the meeting on the 24th November 2025 and the work was completed in January 2026.

Appropriate signage was also installed around the hall and residents of the parish were informed on the implementation of CCTV via the parish magazine and the Buriton Parish Council Facebook page.

For information purposes, Buriton Parish Council is a small organisation, currently with only five Councillors, which meets six times per year and employs a part time Clerk for six hours each week.
